SPOTLIGHT ON THE GOSPEL

JN 1: 35-42

What are you looking for? These are Jesus's first words in the Gospel of John. This

question is addressed to all followers of Christ. Perhaps we are searching for happiness, peace, fulfillment, rest or something else – which are only found in knowing, loving and serving Jesus Christ, by serving our brothers and sisters in need.

He said to them, "Come, and you will see." The Catechism of the Catholic Church states (CCC356) that all human beings are called by God to share in God's divine life. The English word vocation comes from the Latin, meaning "a calling" or "a summoning".

In today's gospel, Andrew discovers Jesus and what does he do? He tells his brother Simon: We have found the Messiah – which is translated Christ. Then he brought him to Jesus. We can sense Andrew's excitement. Andrew responds to the call to discipleship by sharing his discovery.

Samuel, in our first reading was already placed in the service of the Lord by his mother. He experiences a divine call. At first Samuel doesn't recognize that God is calling him. At that time Samuel was not familiar with the Lord, because the Lord had not revealed anything to him as yet. God's call is persistent. With the help of the high priest, Eli, Samuel discerns that it is the Lord who calls him. Samuel answered, "Speak, for your servant is listening." Let's also say to the Lord: Speak, for your servant is listening. May we respond in trust, so that others experience God's love through us.




