
Spotlight on the Gospel Jn 7 37-39

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." The followers of Jesus were afraid. They feared that they too would be put to death, like Jesus. Then what happened? Jesus appears to them in his glorified body, not subject to time or space and says: "Receive the Holy Spirit..."

Imagine being in that upper room with the apostles when the risen Jesus is revealed to them and they received the Holy Spirit – now they see Jesus in a whole new way! Pentecost is about seeing Jesus in a whole new way – a new revelation.

The Holy Spirit comes to each one of us in fire! He will burn away the things that keep us from Jesus. He will lighten the "baggage" of fear, anxiety, resentment and worry in our hearts. The Holy Spirit is the Sanctifier – the One who makes us holy!

Jesus speaks to his disciples prior to his passion and death: "When the Advocate comes whom I will send you from the Father, the Spirit of truth that proceeds from the Father, he will testify to me...he will guide you to all truth...will declare to you the things that are coming...He will glorify me..." The Holy Spirit will guide us to the Truth, Jesus Christ and we too will witness to his love in the world which we live! Come Holy Spirit!


